



## DIY Vinegar non selective Herbicide solution

1 cup of vinegar ( Regular or Apple cider)

1 Tbs salt (Table, Epsom, Sea salt all can work, I like Sea salt)

1 drop of Dawn dish soap ( preferably the regular kind, aka Blue or green one we dont need soft hands here with Olay additives) this helps it stick around longer.

Mix in a spray bottle, lable it!!!

Now go out and shoot those pesky weeds , works best in strong daylight.

Use caution when applying: this works for most average weeds, but can kill your landscape plants as well depending on the saturation level. It will kill grass. Has not been effective on creeping charlie. For use on thistles try "shooting" right in the center of the stalk, as the rest of the leaves will repel it, has been seen to have a better rate when applied this way, but not perfect. We recommend to use a shield like cardboard to protect you desired lawn or plants. Will need re- application if it rains with in a few hours.

Other notes: Vinegar is an acid that will build up in the soil over time and use, this is not an ideal PH for many plants and can cause root burn. Do not apply more than needed. Try to apply to foliage /stems vs soil. Do give it a few days to show its response. Do not apply on soil the is to be newly planted with tender roots the same week.
